



## Elements, Characteristics, Abilities, Qualifications of a Fully Equipped Saint

1. Must seek to have an **INTIMATE PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP** with the Lord Jesus Christ:
  - 1) Learning to live a **LIFE of Prayer**.
    - Establishing a habit of daily prayer is a good start!
    - Connecting with God FIRST before you start your day.
    - Then being “available” to connect with God at any time of the day.
  - 2) Seeking for His will AND being **SUBMITTED to the will of God** – EVERYDAY!
    - Having a revelation of iniquity and a strong conviction against it!
  - 3) Living a fully **REPENTANT** life - continually seeking to **DIE** to SELF, Pride, Impure motives, and Iniquity AND to **GROW** in God’s love, humility and character.
    - **Repentance** changes us from the inside – out.
  - 4) Committed to **KNOWING the Word of God**.
    - Having the foundation of the Apostolic Doctrine.
    - Being DISCIPLED in the Word of God by the ministry of *Teaching* that is available in the body of Christ that you are a part of.
    - Establishing a lifestyle of studying the Word of God (to hide it in our hearts AND to learn “new” things).
    - Gaining an appetite for the MEAT of God’s Word.
    - Receiving the biblical revelation of the ONENESS of God and OUTWARD Holiness (i.e. modesty, gender differentiation, pleasing God vs. man, etc)
  - 5) Learning how to **CAST OUR CARES** on the Lord and to **Seek God’s PEACE** DAILY.
    - Allowing us to hear Him more clearly so that we can follow His leading.
    - Allowing His peace (or lack of peace) to confirm the working of His will in our daily life.
    - Releasing our control and learning to fully trust in Him.
  - 6) Seeking and receiving spiritual **WHOLENESS** by dealing with ALL of our SHAME.
    - Receiving personal deliverance by prayer and by the ministry of the body.
    - Learning to LIVE in God’s **RIGHTEOUSNESS, PEACE** and **JOY**.
  - 7) Seeking God’s complete **DELIVERANCE** from habitual sin and making a decision to guard our eyes with the things that we do or watch.
  - 8) Seeking to consciously live with **Purified MOTIVES**.
  - 9) Living a life dependent upon God’s **GRACE** and not relying on our own strength.
    - Also seeking to continually GROW in God’s grace (2 Peter 3:18).

- 10) We must have **TRUST in God** and be able to have **FAITH** in His promises – regardless of our circumstances (i.e. not falling into depression, condemnation or isolation whenever you experience a challenge or trial).
  - 11) Learning how to **HEAR the VOICE of God** (and becoming more sensitive to it).
  - 12) Being **submitted** and **obedient** to the **Word of God** and to the leading of His **SPIRIT/Voice of God**.
  - 13) Living in the **Flow of His SPIRIT** – being dependent and content with His Spirit.
  - 14) Focused on being a **CONDUIT** for the Lord to **FLOW** and **MINISTER** through us.
2. **Being SUBMITTED to the OVERSIGHT** God has placed over us in order to be covered by the Lord's AUTHORITY as the only Biblical means to have His Authority.
    - Being faithful to hear God's Rhema and to receive ministry through them.
    - Being accountable to God's authority in your life.
    - Seeking their guidance or confirmation when making important decisions.
  3. Being a peace-lover and full of God's Spirit to be able to **DEAL** with **OFFENSES** quickly.
  4. Displays a **GOOD EXAMPLE** in faithfulness, attitude, ministry, worship and prayer.
  5. Being committed to **PARTICIPATE in KINGDOM PRAYING** DAILY as a PRIORITY.
  6. We must be able to PRAY "**ALL KINDS OF PRAYER**" and be involved in **Corporate** prayer.
  7. We must be able to **MINISTER** to **PEOPLE'S NEEDS** (i.e. praying for the sick, speaking faith, casting out spirits, etc.).
  8. We must learn to **OPERATE** in at least **ONE** of the **GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT** for the Edification of the Body (9 Gifts of the Spirit, 5-fold giftings, and supporting gifts).
  9. We must be able to **PRAY for PEOPLE to RECEIVE** the **BAPTISM** of the **Holy Ghost**.
  10. We must be **involved** in a Connect Group to participate in the Apostolic "**House to House**" ministry of the New Testament Church.
  11. To have a revelation and understanding of and to fully participate with the Savior in the **GREAT COMMISSION** (i.e. possessing the same love that He has for the lost).
  12. We must be able to **TEACH/EXPLAIN** the foundational doctrines of Christ.
  13. We must be able to **SHARE** our **TESTIMONY** and the **GOSPEL** (the GOOD NEWS).
  14. We must seek to live an "**EMPOWERED LIFE**" which becomes a **FRUITFUL Life** (winning and discipling souls).
